Prior to moving into the safety profession, he was in-charge of projects and construction activities in Tata Steel's Engineering Division for about 16 years. He is a strategist with competency in devising and implementing safety management systems for maintaining sound safety processes in the organization. He is a professional with people management skills and the capability to manage change with ease. He was a part-time faculty at the Industrial Safety Institute in Jamshedpur (Jharkhand Govt. affiliated) for about 5 years (2010–2014) as a subject matter expert in construction safety.
